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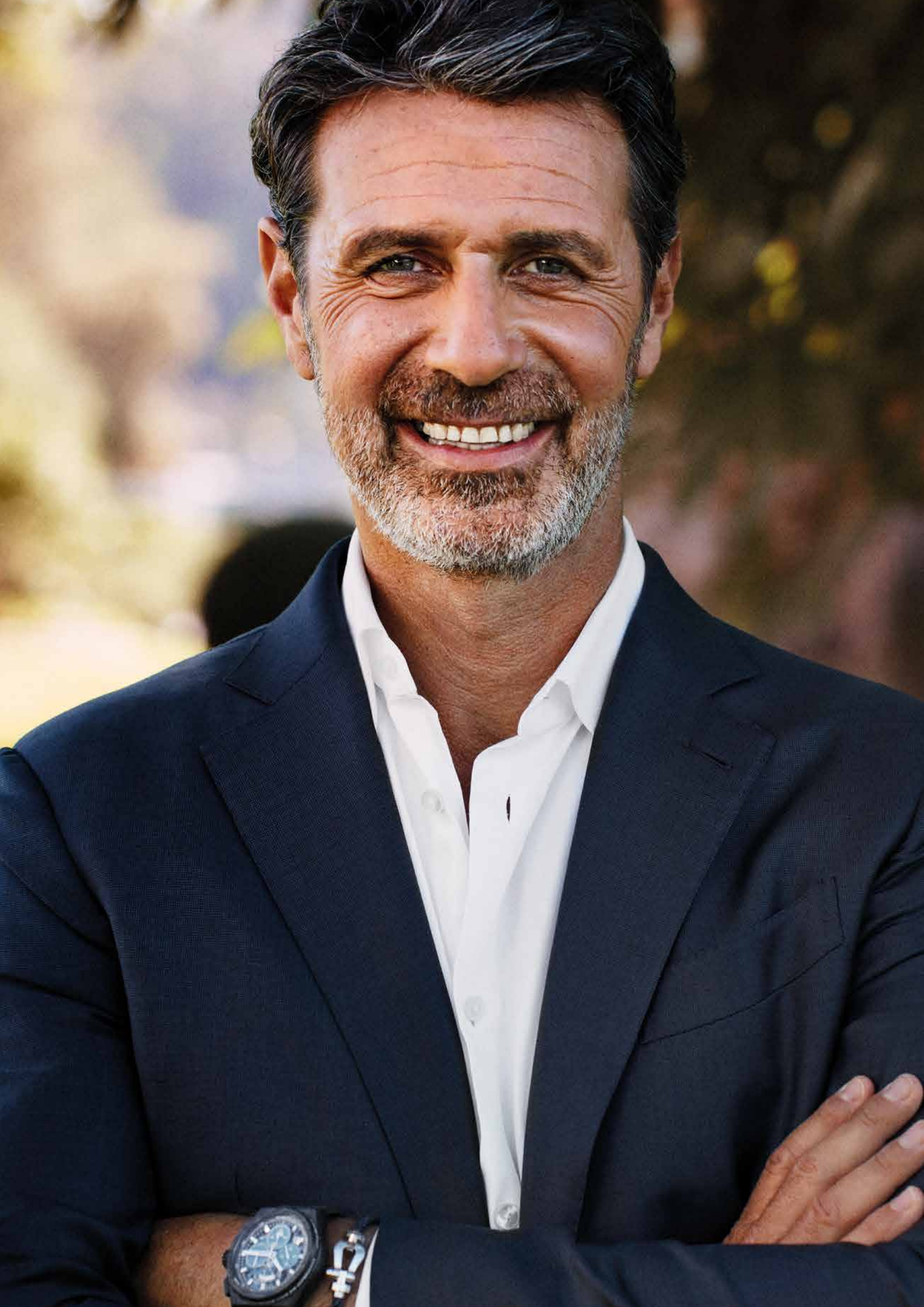

As Serena Williams' tennis coach for ten years, Patrick Mouratoglou helped to steer her to 10 out of 23 of her Grand Slam wins.

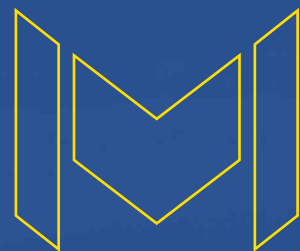

## ACADEMICS

TAILOR-MADE FOR OPTIMUM PERFORMANCE

### KEY STAGE 3 (11-14 YEARS)

- > Foundational study to prepare students before commencing their IGCSE courses in Year 10
- > English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities, Computer Science, Art, Drama, Modern Foreign Languages - *French, Spanish, Mandarin, Malay*

### KEY STAGE 4 (14-16 YEARS)

- > In Years 10 and 11, students work towards their IGCSE qualifications. These are highly regarded courses designed and accredited by UK examination boards.
- > Core IGCSE Subjects: English language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics
- > IGCSE Options: Business, History, Geography, Sport, Computer Science, Art and Design, Drama, Modern Foreign Languages - *French, Spanish, Mandarin, Malay*
- > Other IGCSE Courses: English Literature, Additional Mathematics

### KEY STAGE 5 (POST-16 STUDY)

- > In Years 12 and 13, students focus on 3 or 4 Advanced Level courses. These qualifications are recognised and valued by all international universities. Many of our students have gained admissions to top universities such as Cambridge, Stanford, Imperial, and the LSE, to name a few.
- > A-Levels: English Literature, Mathematics, Further Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Business, Economics, History, Politics Geography, Computer Science, Art and Design, Drama, Modern Foreign Languages - *French, Spanish, Mandarin, Malay*

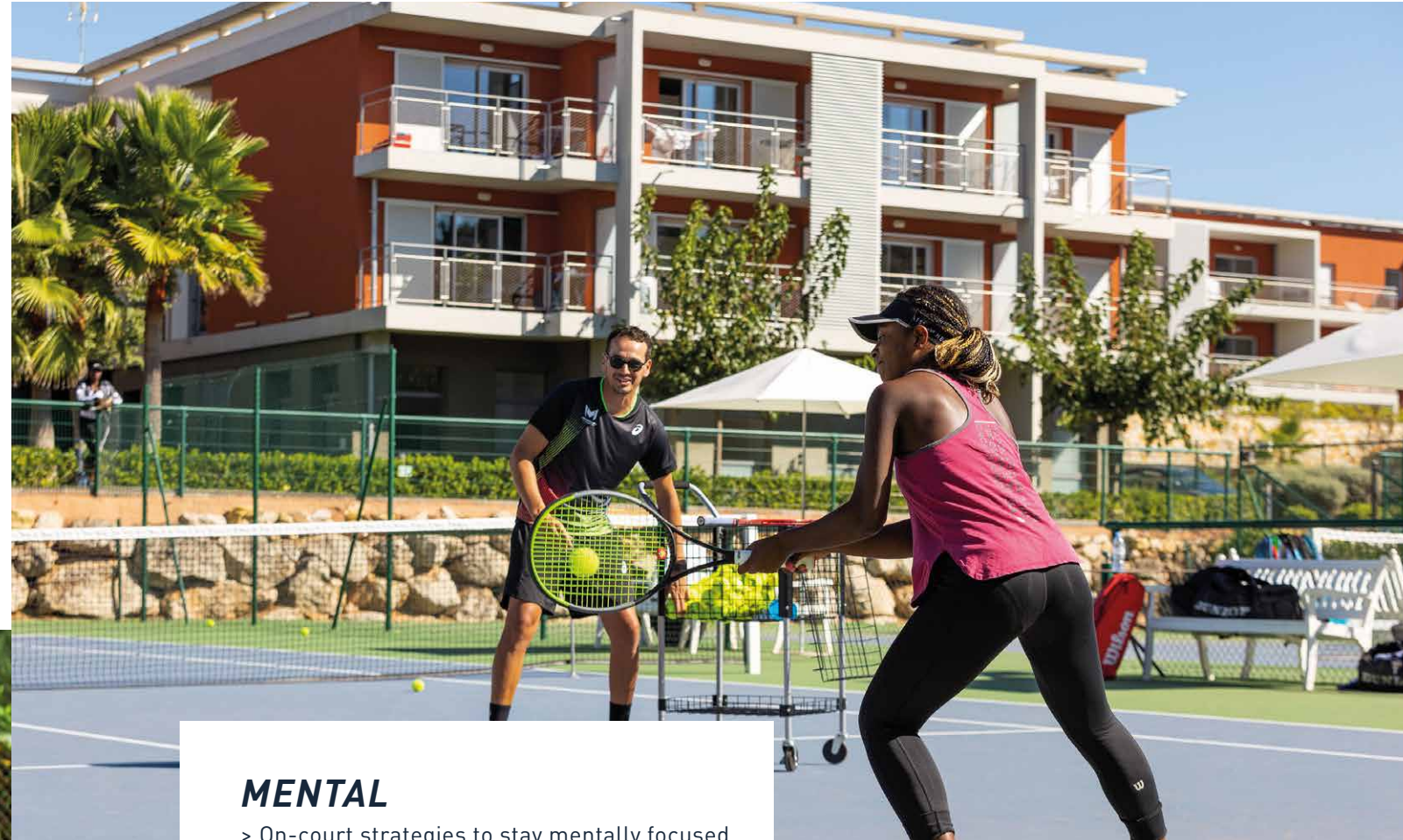
# TENNIS

## WEEKLY TRAINING SCHEDULE



### TENNIS

- > Up to 3 hours daily
- > Saturday match training
- > 4 players per group
- > Groups of same level
- > *Individual coaching lessons (at an additional charge)*



### MENTAL

# THE EPSOM ADVANTAGE

Programme participants also benefit from the Epsom Advantage, a bespoke university support programme that provides each student with a clearly defined roadmap, a collaborative effort between student, mentors and parents, that outlines different objectives students must meet in the lead-up to a successful application to a top-tier university (eg. summer applications, essay development, research, scholarship and internship opportunities). The programme also provides promising student-athletes with the training rigour to apply to colleges where the duality between tennis and academics can be explored further.

Participants in the Mouratoglou Tennis Programme also have access to a US Scholarship Coordinator at the Mouratoglou Academy, who will advise and guide students to find a suitable college to both continue their academic journey and further professional career.

# PASTORAL CARE

## WELCOME HOME

*We want young people to join us full of potential and to leave us successful and fulfilled, with a sense of connection to a supportive, nurturing community.*

At Epsom Malaysia we are an international community whose strength lies in the emphasis it places on discipline, tolerance and the understanding of one another. Teachers and support staff in both the Prep and Senior School develop a personal care for, and interest in, individual pupils; to draw out their passions and interests, to ensure their time at the School is rewarding. The wellbeing and safety of all our pupils is paramount. Our pastoral care is primarily rooted in the House system, which provides the much-needed guidance and support for each child. All Senior School students are a member of a Boarding House which becomes a second family; a tight knit community of young people who learn and develop together; sharing moments and forging memories of their life as an Epsom pupil.

In select instances, Year 5 and Year 6 students may be considered for the Flagship Tennis & School Programme should the coaches deem them suitable. In-person evaluation camps will take place with Mouratoglou Academy coaches. For those unable to attend, video submissions will also be accepted.

**Note that the following are not included:**

**Academic & Boarding**

External examination charges, field trips, music fees and school uniforms.

**Tennis**

Tournament fees and trips, medical insurance, physiotherapy and relevant sports equipment. These will be invoiced as appropriate.

**\*Weekday Boarding**, Monday to Friday, is available for Malaysian and Singapore residents and has a separate fee structure.
